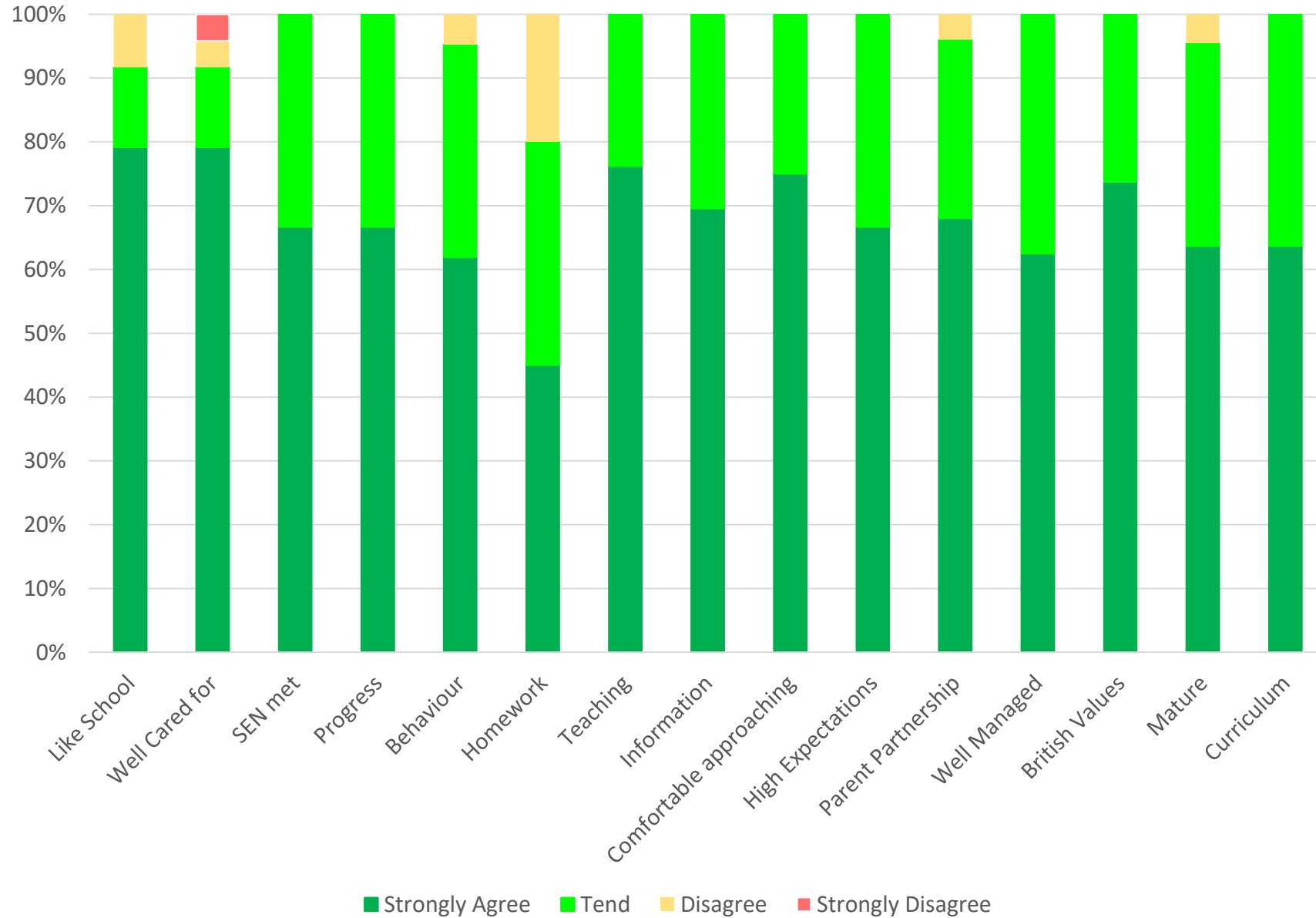
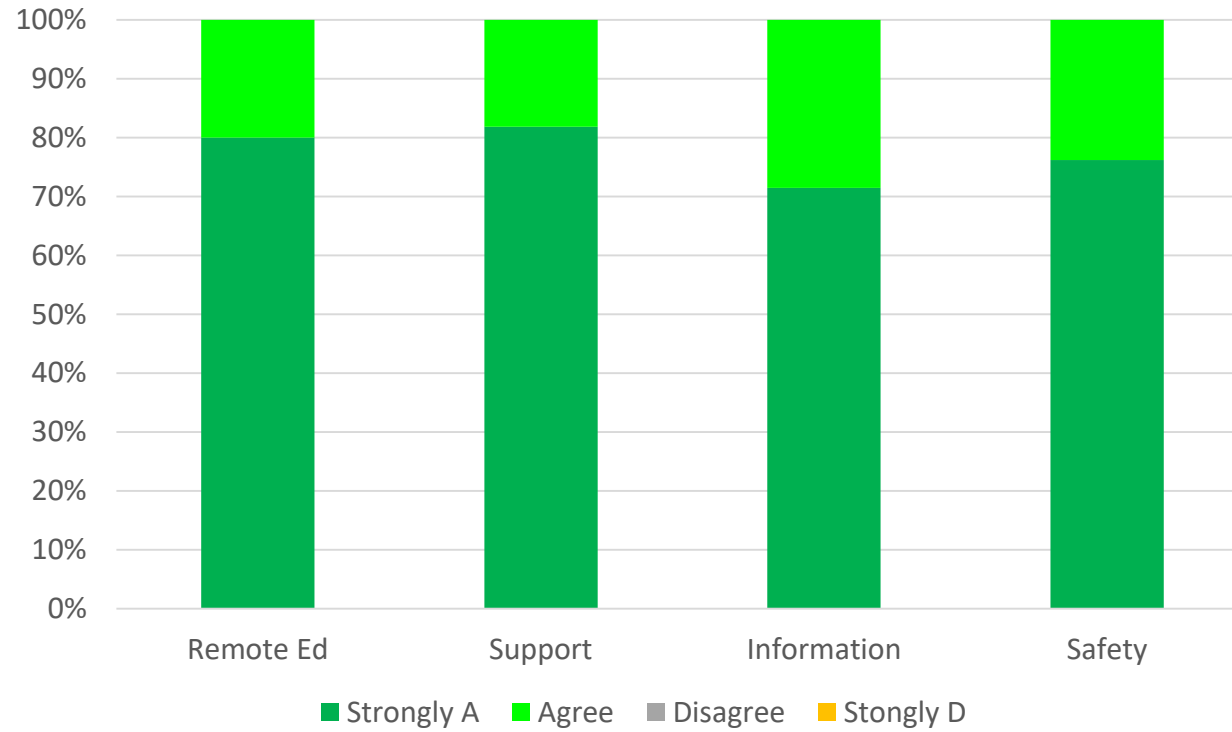


Parent Survey Results 2021 *

Summary and school response:

Thank you to all our parents who returned our survey. We always welcome feedback – both ongoing and through this questionnaire. It is really useful whether is good or to be told of anything you think we can improve upon.

Each of the parents who indicated that they ‘disagreed’ with a positive statement has now had a constructive conversation with school and we really hope that we have been able to move things forwards for their experience of school to the maximum extent possible within the wider policies and procedures of the school that remain suitable for others and can’t be themselves improved through the feedback. We review our information systems where parents report that they don’t know the answer to a question.

We continue to work on getting the right amount of home-learning for each child and family. Some pupils struggle with the distinction between home and school, some parents have requested more set tasks and others report that it is not feasible to support their child with school set tasks at home. We will keep working to improve in this area.

We are truly pleased and thankful that so many parents and pupils are so positive about what we provide at Cromwell and your feedback really helps to spur us on in our journey to keep improving for our fantastic pupils and students. It is particularly reassuring that all respondents report they feel comfortable about approaching school, that their child’s education needs are met, that they are making good progress and that we have been supportive throughout the pandemic.
