## Pupil Premium 2018- 2019

Pupil Premium funding is the additional money we receive based on the number of Looked After Children and Children on free school meals at Cromwell. Schools are free to spend the Pupil Premium as they see fit, however we are accountable as to how the additional funding has been used to support pupils from low income families and those that are looked after.

During the Financial year 2018-19 we will receive £20570 Pupil Premium funding. During the Financial year 2018-19 we will receive £16200 LAC funding.

The funding criteria means that **22** of our **72** pupils will benefit from Pupil Premium funding. **9** out of **72** pupils will benefit from LAC funding.

The total money we will receive will be £36770.

The following Data from 2017/18 has been used to plan the year and decide on where resources are needed.
